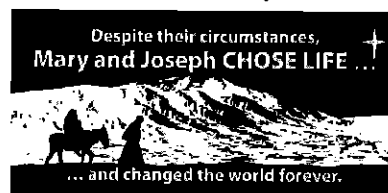

Message from Mike Hoover about abortion Wednesday, October 5, 2011, in Waco

Today, 11 young women realized both the spiritual and physical horrors of their decision to end the lives of their children. A handful of stalwart pro-lifers in the Waco community stood strong at the 'gates of hell', on that thin red line between life and death.

We were blessed to have a special guest with us – Carol Everett of the Heidi Foundation. Carol provided us insight into the latest legislation at our State's capitol hill, as well as an update on the transfer of federal/state monies to Federally Qualified Health Centers (Title 10 Money), rather than Planned Parenthood. Carol's organization is helping facilitate that process.

The eleventh and final young lady to enter Planned Parenthood was a beautiful Hispanic young girl with her mother (the grandmother). This young girl didn't look older than 14 yrs old, and the grandmother looked to be in her early thirties. They were obviously conflicted about the decision to have an abortion. The young mother really didn't want to go through it, but the young grandmother was adamant for her to do so. Apparently, the unborn baby was interracial because the grandmother was making several insults to the young girl about the "black father". It was a very distressing time. We were reaching out desperately in love and support to the young girl as best as we could in the parking lot. We didn't realize at the time that there was another young woman in her car listening to us as well. The grandmother drove her blue SUV with the mother right to the door of the clinic, and escorted her in. She came back to the car and parked it, and ran back to the clinic as fast as she could.

We were feeling very dispirited about the situation with the mother and grandmother. We were struggling in prayer and debate about it behind the PLW truck when suddenly the other young mother (with an infant baby) that was in the parking lot that overheard us came over to us. To keep her name anonymous, I'll call her "Jane". Jane drove over to the curb and began speaking with Cindy, one of our pro-life sidewalk counselors. Jane was from Killeen and received a chemical abortion from PP via RU 486 a few weeks ago on Monday. Jane was devastated by her decision to have an abortion. For three days, she was in such excruciating pain that she had to leave her young baby in the care of her sister while she endured the terrible effects of the chemical abortion. She shared with us that on the first night of the chemical abortion, there were demons that tormented her in her dreams. Jane was so fearful and afraid that she repented and gave her life to Christ. She was only at PP to receive her follow up medical visit, and they wouldn't see her. She told us that after the abortion, PP didn't care about her at all. Jane was very upset at them and wanted to file a complaint, so we provided her some information to do so. Jane was so moved by what she heard and wanted to share it with us; therefore, she called us all over to her car to tell us directly. She told us if someone would have been present that Monday telling her that we would support & love her as well, she would have not gone through with her abortion. I responded to her by saying, "you may realize it, but you provided us with a blessing by telling us that".

Because of Jane's testimony of pain, suffering, repentance, redemption, and forgiveness, it confirmed in our hearts that what we were doing is of God's will in our lives. We were all moved and touched by this story, and I thought it best to share with everyone.

Lord, You empower us with Your Spirit to do your will in the earth. Send us to the poorest, the most broken, the most captive, the most blind and the most oppressed in the world, the innocent pre-born children in their mother's wombs that are scheduled for destruction. Help us to bring them healing, liberty, sight and justice through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Orphans and Super-Orphans

Orphans.

The thought of children living without parents tugs at our heartstrings.

With control of many diseases and safer workplaces, we encounter fewer orphans than in past decades.

A significant part of my family life in Colorado was relationships with orphaned cousins—three brothers and two sisters. Following the death of their widowed mother, all except the youngest were placed in an orphanage. The youngest, a daughter, remained with her aunt.

The siblings were able to leave the orphanage for my mother (their aunt) and father's wedding in 1933. Following the festive marriage celebration, the children did not return. Their aunt assumed responsibility for all. Additionally, my mother and father nurtured and guided the children through the years. As adults, my cousins experienced many of life's travails, but lead productive and significant lives.

My orphan cousins are now deceased. They and their children have been a big part of my life. And, I have been inspired by how my mother, father, and aunt responded to the Biblical call to support and love the orphan.

While orphans are not common today, there is a related experience that is all too common. This is what I will call the "super-orphan." The super-orphan does not outlive his or her parents. Super-orphans die because of parental rejection. One or both parents reject the child to procure an abortion.

As with the orphan of old, the reality of the super-orphan arouses sadness and sympathy. The Bible does not explicitly command us to defend super-orphans. In biblical times there was no nation that aborted tens of thousands of its innocent unborn. Still, we can read the Bible, put two and two together, and know we should step out in their defense. Just as we are called to reach out to orphans in their years of life, we must rise to defend super-orphans at their hours and minutes of imminent death.

Dedicated pro-lifers around the country and in Waco do speak and act for the super-orphan. I'm proud of those in Waco who stand and pray for the unborn at risk. These brave hearts are from Ayolandra to Vincent, and so many in between.

I have joined public witness to appeal the death sentences declared for the innocent unborn. On this day, I implore the managers, employees, board members and supporters of Planned Parenthood Waco to step back, to reconsider what you are doing, and then STOP.
