

40 Days for Life fall campaign

September 27 through November 4, 2017

Waco has joined to be one of 371 cities worldwide

40 Days for Life international headquarters announced in a webinar on August 31, 2017 that its fall 40 Days for Life prayer vigil has will the largest since this dynamic pro-life initiative went national in 2007. There will be campaigns in 371 cities in over 30 countries. For example, there will be prayer vigils in 17 cities in Mexico and 20 in Columbia.

40 Day for Life was started by the Brazos Valley Coalition for Life in College Station.

In Waco, the prayer vigil will be 7 am to 7 pm (except Sunday) for the 40 days. The location for prayer is the sidewalks of the Planned Parenthood abortion center at 1121 Ross Avenue. After four years with no abortions committed in Waco, abortions resumed the week after Easter of 2017. This facility at 1121 Ross Avenue is designed to be the abortion magnet for dozens of Central Texas counties east and west of Interstate 35 in addition to Baylor University and Texas A&M University.

We pray for individual babies and moms and those who may be encouraging abortion. We pay for conversion of those who support and perform abortions. We pray for an end to abortion in Waco.
