


Video Night: Selected Undercover Videos on the Market for Fetal Organs

The first of 12 undercover videos was released on July 14, 2015 and immediately launched legal and moral controversy. The Center for Medical Progress was the organization that produced and released the videos under the direction of 27-year old David Daleiden.



1 CMP Video #3. Introductory segments.

Dr. Deborah Nucatola. Senior Director of Medical Services for Planned Parenthood Federation of America. Nucatola is PPFA's "Top Doc". Nucatola describes how she handled organ harvesting with 8 late-term abortions the previous day. She called one "a 17-weeker."

Holly O'Donnell (Ex-Procurement Technician, StemExpress) How one abortion delivered a fully intact fetus.

Perrin Lanton. (Procurement Manager, Advanced Bio-Science Resources) Delivery of a fully intact fetus is something that frequently happens.

Melissa Ferrell, (Director of Research for Planned Parenthood of the Gulf Coast). Talk about altering the abortion method in order to deliver a fully intact fetal cadaver. This outcome is very advantageous for harvesting fetal organs.

2 CMP Video #6. Holly O'Donnell (Ex-Procurement Technician, StemExpress). The setting: Holly O'Donnell is one of four Stem Express procurement technicians going out to Planned Parenthood abortion facilities in California to harvest tissue and organs to be sold by Stem Express to researchers.

Theme #1. Consent requirements for fetal tissue/organs harvested were frequently violated.

Theme #2. The environment of working in an abortion facility is very negative.

Consent violation #1. Women were pressured.

Consent violation #2. Women were "consented" before they have made up their mind to have an abortion.

Consent violation #3. Organs were harvested and sold without a woman's consent.

People at Planned Parenthood facilities in CA performed medical procedures for which they were not licensed.

3 CMP Video #8. Cate Dyer, founder and CEO of StemExpress. Dyer talks about the StemExpress role in fetal organ market and possibility of buying fetal specimens from Center for Medical Progress.

StemExpress pays Planned Parenthood \$50 to \$75 per fetal organ.

Stem Express frequently acquires intact fetuses. Researchers often freak out when the whole fetus arrives.

Dyer would really be happy if StemExpress could acquire an additional 50 livers per week.

Contaminated fetal specimens are a problem for researchers. Dyer says some abortion facilities are so contaminated, one wonders if they should be allowed to perform abortions.

Dyer says StemExpress acquires tissue from nearly 100 abortion facilities—Planned Parenthood and independents.

Dyer feels affirmed and supported by Planned Parenthood national leadership.

Dyer's sense is that Planned Parenthood feels they are being treated well financially in the fetal organ market.

4 CMP Video #5. Melissa Ferrell, Director of Research for Planned Parenthood of the Gulf Coast (Houston). Dialogue about possibility of selling fetal organs to Center for Medical Progress. Ferrell does not appear to be a medical professional.

Begins with some powerful news media clips about the fetal organ market.

A lot about how PPGC optimizes the finances for fetal harvesting and distribution.

Intact fetuses from abortion facilitates very profitable line item accounting.

President of Gulf Coast Planned Parenthood won't talk money. Refers all questions to Melissa Ferrell.
