◆ Abortion resumed in Waco

March 3, 2021 was a tragic day in the history of Waco. **Abortion returned to Planned Parenthood** after a suspension for almost a year. The main focus of PLW is closing Planned Parenthood in Central Texas. It is a tremendous burden to realize that **Waco is one of the eight abortion cities in Texas.**

◆ Two Amazing Developments in January

There has never been a **"signature" newspaper ad** like this in Texas. In October of 2020, Pro-Life Waco contracted for a full-page ad in the *Waco Tribune-Herald* for January 22, 2021. The ad featured a **call for the reversal of the Roe v Wade Supreme Court decision.** We had a goal of 600 names on the ad. Pro-Life Waco asked for a donation of \$5 to \$50 for each individual or family on the ad and reached the goal of 600. The ad made a strong proclamation to our Central Texas neighbors and gave our pro-life friends one more way to participate in the battle against abortion in our community. Because of COVID-19, the annual Texas Rally for Life in Austin was a live stream that integrated presentations from 8 Texas cities. **"Rally for Life Waco"** included outdoor live stream viewing at Care Net. KWTX-TV aired a news story. 60 to 70 local foot soldiers attended the events adjacent to Planned Parenthood. We ran out of tacos. The speakers from Waco were John Pisciotta (Pro-Life Waco) and Deborah McGregor (Care Net Pregnancy Center).

The billboard truck is also a mobile warehouse. That function was sorely missed for two months.

◆ New Ventures for Life in 2021

German Public Radio featured Pro-Life Waco. As the U.S. correspondent for German Public Radio, Doris Simon wanted to find out about pro-life activism in the U.S. Somehow, her internet search led to a phone call to PLW's John Pisciotta, who arranged a full day of interviews outside of Planned Parenthood on June 18. The result was a 6-minute mini-documentary that included sidewalk counselling, public square outreach, billboards and yard signs, and our campaign to persuade WACOAN magazine to stop taking ads from Planned Parenthood. To step up the challenge to the Planned Parenthood Regional Abortion Center, **Rise Up in Waco** began in February. We hold strong, G-rated signs at the extensive public right-of-way along HWY 6. The outreach is 8 to 10 AM, with a "Fiesta del Ranchito" taco break at 9 AM. Currently, **Rise Up in Waco is twice monthly**, including the 4th Saturday of each month. We aspire to 77 or more foot soldiers standing for life 4th Saturdays. (See adjacent photo.)

Fly the Flag to Honor Babies Aborted. This is the 3rd of each month because abortion resumed in Waco on March 3, 2021. August 3 was the launch of this outreach. Households and churches fly the American flag on the 3rd of each month -- half-staff if possible. Over 20,000 innocent babies have been killed in Waco. See photo below.
