

## Battling for life in the Post-Roe era

The heightened challenges of 2023 follow a tumultuous 2022.

On June 24, 2022 the Supreme Court handed down its long awaited Dobbs decision, which completely toppled Roe v Wade.

With Roe gone, both sides pivoted to moral, cultural and political engagements in anticipation of the November 2022 general election. As election day approached, hopes were high for pro-life gains. Those hopes were not realized. Congressional gains were small. Moreover, the pro-life side lost in all six states with abortion directly on the ballot.

In 2023 the abortion battle rages on. Pro-Life Waco will deliver more than its fair share of the heavy lifting. Our major lane of action is public square outreach, as in the past. Public square or community outreach penetrates a local community broadly and strongly to help change hearts and minds and souls. Pro-Life Waco continues as the Texas leader for public square outreach. Moreover, PLW is a model for the rest of America.

# Monthly CVS pharmacy protests launch on March 31

Pro-Life Waco responds in the public square to new pro-abortion threats. In January, CVS and Walgreens pharmacy chains accepted the Biden administration offer to profit from prescriptions for the abortion pill, mifepristone. Pro-Life Waco launched "Protest CVS" on March 31 from 11:30 AM to 1 PM. The location for one Friday each month is 601 N Valley Mills Drive, at the super-busy intersection with New Road.

### Sidewalk counseling support

Sidewalk counseling at the entrance to Planned Parenthood continues under the leadership of Ellen Staniszewski. Planned Parenthood remains open on weekdays even with the Texas abortion ban. Pro-life Waco provides logistical and financial support.

Carolyn, the Pro-Life billboard truck, is on duty adjacent to Planned Parenthood for the distribution and return of blessing bags and other materials used by sidewalk counselors.

Financially, Pro-Life Waco pays for breakfasts for sidewalk counselors at Our Breakfast Place on alternate months. Financial support also includes contents of blessing bags given to Planned Parenthood clients and for training seminars for sidewalk counseling.



### PLW crushes PP's sex ed seminar

What was the surprise? Pro-Life Waco discovered the time and location and immediately mobilized for a sidewalk protest at the venue.

Pro-Life Waco Director John Pisciotta declared, "Our engagement in the public square can have much greater impact than we imagine. Moreover, the hurdles to our engagements to uphold righteousness are much lower than we imagine."

### East Texas Right to Life honors PLW as Texas organization of the year

East Texas Right to Life honored Pro-Life Waco as the outstanding organization in Texas for 2022. The award was conferred on March 11, 2023, at the ETRTL annual banquet in Longview. East Texas Right to Life is the mother organization for the dynamic Sanctuary Cities for the Unborn campaign headed by Mark Lee Dickson. Mr. Dickson and PLW's John Pisciotta share a commitment to public square outreach at the local level. Mark's leadership has brought over 60 Sanctuary Cities for the Unborn to Texas, including nearby Crawford.

A dozen PLW foot soldiers went on a joyride to Fort Worth on April 25. PLW foot soldiers work hard in the battle, however, not around the clock. That is where outdoor signs come in and have a big impact.

There is Carolyn, the billboard truck.
Carolyn is typically parked at Planned
Parenthood during the week and then out to a
local church on the weekend.

PLW currently has eight 5'x 11' "junior" billboards with messages and locations rotating through the year. Friends in McGregor like our location near the town Dairy Queen (photo below). With Roe struck down it is very important to display the message that abortion hurts women.



Finally, we have yard signs for homes and churches. "Love Both, Choose Life" is most popular. Pick up your free yard sign at 4200 Grim Ave. (Home/office of PLW.)

#### Federal court challenge to FDA

This is the second time for PLW on German Public Radio. The focus of the interview was the Federal Court case proceeding in Amarillo. A lawsuit claimed the FDA violated law by approving mifepristone for abortion use in 2000 under an expedited "emergency" investigation. The interview aired on March 16.
